Greetings from Sirsa!

I would like to express my appreciation and gratitude to our teaching faculty who leave no stone unturned to tap the potentials of every student and thus bring about an all-round development. On the academic front, I wish to suggest a few points and expect whole-hearted cooperation from you :

- I wish to bring to your notice that many of the auto-rickshaws are over-crowded and they lack safety measures for the students who play by it. This is particularly in the case of Kindergarten Section children. The School will not be responsible for any unforeseen incidents that may occur once the student is handed over to the auto-rickshaw drivers/cycle rickshaw pullers. It is unfortunate that the auto rickshaw drivers refrain from cooperating and tend to play games with the rules of the School.
- You are requested to kindly maintain proper parking decorum at the Main gate whenever you come to drop or pick your ward. Avoid making a haste and thus cluttering the road with traffic congestion.
- We are reforming the traffic system for the good will of all stake holders. We seek your cooperation. Kindly use two wheeler only to drop your ward to school. It is our humble request to you to use the road which is coming to school main gate. Please do not use the *station road*. *It will be used by auto rickshaws and buses. Kindly pay heed to the employees appointed on duty and respect them.*


For Students

5. All the students from std Ist - XII who come by their vehicles would use the road just opposite to the main gate of our school, not the one which is near the railway station.
